Swift 2009	With the Swift release for Cash in 2009, we will be ensuring that the new code for Country can be processed for incoming payments.
Payment Events Export	Cash Payments export provides basic payment data including the latest verification and release events. The record contains a timestamp and user ID for each verify or release event.

Securities

QTS Investigations	We have laid the foundation for the creation of related investigations from securities transactions in the future. This includes preparations within the application and the connections to the corresponding system.
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CLS Third Party

CLS Reporting: Non-Alleged Trades	Alleged trades, when updated to No Longer Alleged (NL), will no longer be displayed in the "All" view of CLS Reporting. However, they will still be available in the "Alleged" view.
CLS Reporting: Duplicate Trades	When an instruction is manually entered or imported the system will check if the trade transaction reference (field 20) has been used and if it is still active in the database. If in use, the system will show an error and save the trade in status "Entered Incomplete" .
