### Fund description

- The investment objective of the fund is to deliver the net total return performance of the MSCI ACWI with Developed Markets 100% hedged to JPY Index less costs.
- The Fund replicates synthetically the index performance by investing in a swap.
- The swap counterparty transfers collateral to the ETF in the form of G10 government bonds, supranational bonds and cash.
- The fund is passively managed.
- The product described herein aligns to Article 6 of Regulation (EU) 2019/2088.

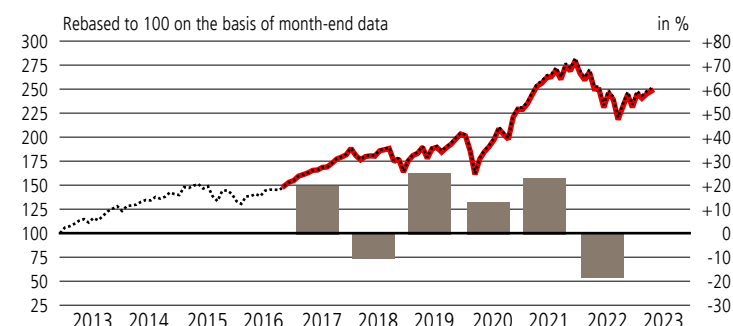

## Risks

In the event that the swap counterparty defaults under the terms of the relevant swap, the fund may suffer a loss. Every fund has specific risks, which can significantly increase under unusual market conditions. Sustainability risks are not considered as part of the Index selection process. Therefore, sustainability risks are not systematically integrated. The fund's assets are passively managed. As a result, the net asset value of the fund's assets is materially dependent on the performance of the underlying investments. Losses that could be avoided via active management will not be offset.
