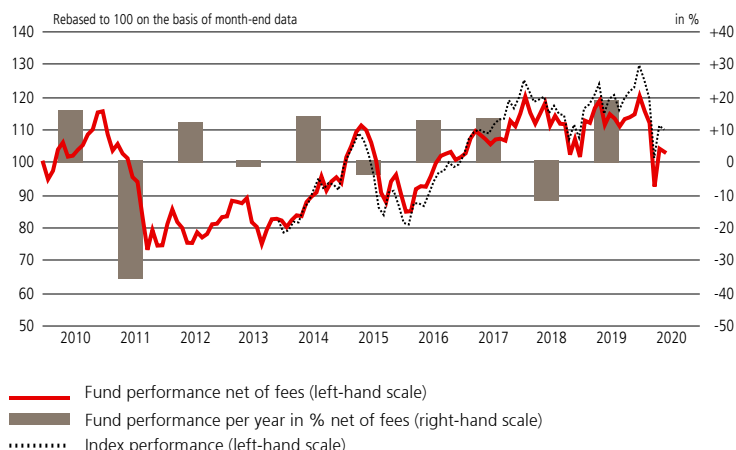
### Fund description
