Fund description

- The actively managed fund invests globally in a diversified range of mainly high-quality bonds, equities as well as alternative investments, including hedge funds.
- Investments are focused on bonds.
- Foreign currencies are largely hedged versus the reference currency. Nevertheless, an active currency strategy is applied if opportunities are seen.
- The fund is based on UBS's investment policy, the UBS House View.
- The fund invests without any benchmark restrictions. The performance of the fund is not benchmarked against an index.

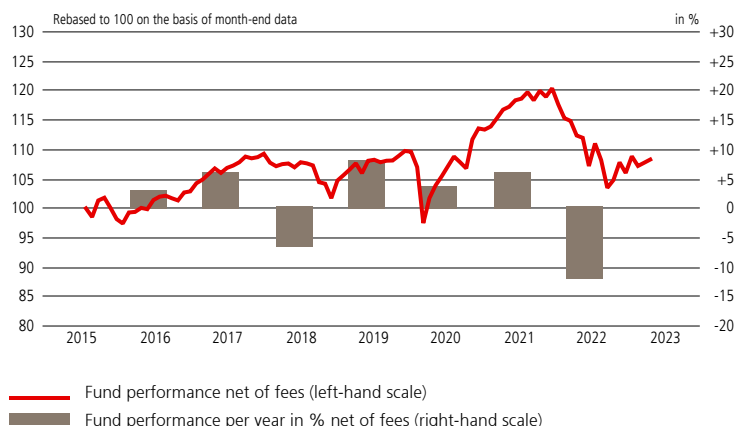

Benefits

The fund offers the investor straightforward and convenient access to UBS House View, which draws on the professional insights of UBS investment specialists worldwide.

The inclusion of alternative investments, including hedge fund investments optimises the portfolio's risk/return profile. Investors benefit globally from diversified market opportunities in a wide variety of asset classes.

The weighting of the different asset classes is maintained within a specific range in order to take account of the fund's risk profile.

The fund is attractive for cautious investors who focus on interest and dividends, but who are also prepared to take on additional risks in order to generate capital gains.

Risks

The fund invests in bonds of varying credit quality, money market securities and equities on a global basis, as well as in alternative forms of investment such as hedge funds. It may therefore be subject to fluctuations in value. The fund may use derivatives which can reduce investment risk or give rise to additional risks (inter alia the counterparty risk). The fund can invest in less liquid assets that may be difficult to sell in the case of distressed markets. It therefore cannot be ruled out that the daily issue and redemption of fund units may be suspended temporarily. The value of a unit may fall below the purchase price.
