UBS Global Coding Challenge – Singapore Edition, 2025

Terms & Conditions

OBJECTIVE

UBS wishes to encourage Undergraduate and Masters University students to consider careers within the UBS Technology (IT) team in Singapore. UBS is proud to introduce UBS Global Coding Challenge – Singapore Edition, an online coding challenge whereby the top three teams will be awarded prizes with a combined value of SG\$1,700 ("UBS Global Coding Challenge – Singapore Edition").

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to enter into UBS Global Coding Challenge – Singapore Edition, participants must be an Undergraduate or Masters University student and scheduled to graduate in 2026, 2027, 2028 or 2029. Participants may form a team of 2-3 eligible participants. Immediate family members of employees at UBS and its subsidiaries and affiliates and past interns or employees at UBS and/or Credit Suisse AG, a UBS Group Company, are not eligible to participate. Each individual participant must submit one application and solution to the problem statement before the application deadline to be considered. No additional team members will be accepted once the shortlisting process is completed. Multiple applications by the same person or team for UBS Global Coding Challenge – Singapore Edition are not permitted and shall result in disqualification.

CONDUCT OF UBS Global Coding Challenge – Singapore Edition

Applications will be reviewed and shortlisted applicants will be selected and invited to participate in a coding challenge ("Coding Challenge") which shall take place online. Each team's solutions to the problems presented during the Coding Challenge ("Solutions") will be assessed at the end of the Coding Challenge.

(i) Application:

Each participant must submit an application providing their CV and solution to the problem statement ("Application"). If a participant is applying as part of a team, he/she should indicate the team name and the full names of all team members in the application so that UBS can make arrangements for the team. The closing date for Application is 23:59 on Sunday, August 3, 2025 (Singapore Time).

Participants will be selected and invited to attend the Coding Challenge during the weekend of September 6 – 7, 2025.

(ii) Coding Challenge:

- The Coding Challenge will take place from the morning of Saturday, September 6, 2025 to the afternoon of Sunday, September 7, 2025.
- Participants are required to attend the Coding Challenge in-person on both days. On Saturday, September 6, 2025 participants are to attend in-person between 9am-6pm and on Sunday, September 7, 2025 between 10am-2pm.
- Teams will be presented with problems at various times throughout the Coding Challenge. The challenges will be hosted on a platform, its URL will be provided to teams prior to the coding challenge.
- Teams are permitted to work on the Solutions to such problems at any time from 09:00 am Saturday, September 6, 2025 to 09:00 am Sunday, September 7, 2025 (Singapore Time).

(iii) Submission of Solutions:

- Each team's Solutions must be submitted to the platform provided by UBS by 09:00 am on Sunday, September 7, 2025 (Singapore Time) ("Submission Deadline") and can also be submitted periodically throughout the weekend onto the provided system prior to the Submission Deadline. Details on the submission of Solutions will be provided during the Coding Challenge.

(iv) Final Evaluation:

- During the Final Evaluation, each team's Solutions will be tested with an automated evaluator developed by UBS ("Automated Evaluator") to assess the Solutions functionality and performance. The team with the highest number of points awarded by the Automated Evaluator will win UBS Global Coding Challenge – Singapore Edition 2025. Further details on the assessment process and the awarding of points will be provided during the Coding Challenge.
- Solutions with broken links or crashes will result in a penalty during the Final Evaluation.
- UBS reserves all rights to develop, make any necessary changes to and interpret any results derived from, the Automated Evaluator, and to do so in its sole and absolute discretion.
- Decisions made by the UBS Panel and/or UBS will be final and binding.

(v) Results:

- The results of UBS Global Coding Challenge – Singapore Edition will be announced on Sunday, September 7, 2025.

The Application, Solutions and any other submissions made in relation to UBS Global Coding Challenge – Singapore Edition 2025 are herein collectively referred to as the "Submissions".

By applying for UBS Global Coding Challenge – Singapore Edition, applicants agree that they have read, understood and agreed to the terms and conditions of UBS Global Coding Challenge – Singapore Edition as set out in this document. Any proposals submitted after any deadline for submissions or not in accordance with these terms and conditions will not be considered.

PRIZES

- Prizes worth the following amounts (per team) will be awarded to the top three teams: SG\$800 for first place; SG\$600 for second place and SG\$300 for third place ("Prizes").
- The ultimate format of the Prizes will be determined by UBS at its sole and absolute discretion.
- Since each team may consist of 2-3 members, the Prize will be shared evenly amongst all members of that team. The Prizes must be accepted as awarded and cannot be transferred, substituted or redeemed for cash.
- UBS reserves the right to substitute any Prize with another prize of an equivalent value. If a Prize becomes unavailable for any reason e.g. cancellation of the UBS Global Coding Challenge – Singapore Edition, UBS shall not be obliged to provide a substitute of equal or higher value or any substitute prize at all.
- Prizes must not be used to fund or support any illegal enterprise or activity.
- If a winning team forfeits his/her/their right to a Prize for any reason, UBS may (but is not obliged to) award the Prize to the team with the next highest score based on the judges' scoring.

 - The content of your or your team's Submissions does not infringe any copyright of any other persons/entities.
 - Your or your team's Submissions do not contain any defamatory statement, offensive and/or illegal material, politically sensitive or offensive content, or contain any content which may infringe the legal rights of any third party relating to privacy, reputation, image, name and other rights of personality as protected by relevant Singapore laws and regulations.
 - Your or your team's Submissions do not disclose or contain any state secret, and are not in breach of any confidentiality obligation under any applicable law or contracts.
