

Notice of Completion on proposed amendments to the methodology of indices comprised in the Credit Suisse Volatility Target Indices

This Notice is addressed to all users and stakeholders of the Credit Suisse Volatility Target Indices (each an “**Index**” and together, the “**Indices**”) listed in the Appendix to this Notice (the “**Appendix**”) and is published by Credit Suisse International (“**CSI**”) in its capacity as Index Administrator (as defined below) in respect of the Indices.

CSI is authorised by the Prudential Regulation Authority (“**PRA**”) and regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority (“**FCA**”) and the PRA. CSI is registered with the FCA as a benchmark administrator.

CSI, acting through its Benchmark Governance Committee, has completed its consultation on proposed amendments (the “**Amendments**”) set out in the Consultation Notice dated 15 May 2024 (the “**Consultation Notice**”) under “Proposed amendments to the Index Methodology” and the Consultation Period has expired.

Terms not defined in this Notice shall be as defined in the Consultation Notice.

CSI as Index Administrator gives notice that following the Consultation it has determined the following:

- the Transfer Effective Date for the Indices is expected to be on or around 20 June 2024; and
- to implement all the Amendments set out in the Consultation Notice and with effect from the Transfer Effective Date.
