



Peer comparison – year end 2006








Sources and uses of capital ¹

Period 2001 - 2006





Decomposition of B/S and RWA by Business Group


RWA - evenly split between IB and GWM&BB, and...






Capital risk-based buffer¹

Creating value

Basel II highlights

Slight decrease in tier 1 ratio, driven by reduction in eligible capital

Shift of RWA from Global WM&BB to IB

Significantly improved disclosure standards
