Starting in 2015, the exchange and the Shanghai Clearing House jointly designed and developed the first carbon financial derivative cleared by the central counterparty in China, the Shanghai Carbon Allowance Forward Products, which will be put into operation in the end of 2016. She lead the team in developing China Security-SEEE Carbon Neutrality Index (Code: 931755) cooperated with Shanghai Stock Exchange and China Securities Index Company.

Participate in top-level design of national carbon market, provide green and low-carbon development consultation for local governments and large enterprises, act as core experts of the World Bank and China-Europe ETS policy dialogue projects, chair or participate as core members in more than 40 national and local governments and international cooperation projects. Published more than 20 papers in core journals, and co-authored seven books on climate change, carbon market, green finance, commodity trading, etc.
