A portion of the distributions constitutes a non-taxable return of capital. See attached for details.

16 Describe the calculation of the change in basis and the data that supports the calculation, such as the market values of securities and the valuation dates ▶ At the close of the Fund's fiscal year on 7/31/2013, the Fund's current & accumulated E&P was calculated under IRC Section 312 as modified by Sec. 852(c) for a Regulated Investment Company (RIC) and the regulations thereunder. The amount of E&P was compared to the amount of the Fund's fiscal year distributions to shareholders. Distributions in excess of E&P were recharacterized as return of capital and should be applied as a reduction in each shareholder's tax basis in the applicable shares.
