**New York, New York – November 14, 2022:** Credit Suisse Asset Management Income Fund, Inc. (NYSE Amex: CIK), a registered closed-end investment company, today announced earnings for the third quarter ended September 30, 2022.

Total net assets of the Fund on September 30, 2022 were \$141,857,191 as compared with \$146,269,016 on June 30, 2022 and \$181,779,914 on September 30, 2021. On September 30, 2022, the net asset value per share was \$2.70 based on 52,627,551 shares outstanding.
